Notice of Harrassment, Threats and Indimidation
Emanating from Without and Within Pennsylvania

Dear Attorney General Corbett:

A Mr. Joseph R. Little of the law firm Shannon, Gracey, Ratliff & Miller, L.L.P. of Houston Texas, who is unlicensed in Pennsylvania, has been sending me correspondence in which he makes slanderous accusations, unfounded assumptions and threats of legal action at the behest of his client, Dresser, Inc., with regards to notary work I had performed for a gentleman in Canada. He is interfering in a private matter to which he is not a party and is trying to coerce me into signing documents which I consider nonsensical. If I don't meet his demands, he will file the lawsuit that he has put together against me.

Pursuant to your oath of office, Attorney General Corbett, I expect you to protect me from such harassment and interference with my business. I ask that you contact the Attorney General in the state of Texas for disciplinary action against Joseph R. Little as he has no business practicing law within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, much less threatening and intimidating a citizen of this state

I am also receiving documents from your Deputy, Kathryn H. Silcox in which she demands a thorough and intrusive investigation into my business practices for no apparent reason. I have asked her for her Supreme Court ID number, for the complainant against me and for other information so I will know what type of matter I'm dealing with, but she refuses and her demands become increasingly more threatening and egregious. I am not involved in any pending court case, yet Ms. Silcox sent me a subpoena in violation of the Pennsylvania Rules of Court, and demands that I answer it or face being "Sanctioned" by the court. If said subpoena is not issued by the court, I have no obligation to answer it, and it would appear that Ms. Silcox is acting outside her authority.

Mr. Corbett, since when has intimidation and tyrannical despotism replaced the Rule of Law in Pennsylvania? Is there any reason why Ms. Silcox should not be disciplined? It is also very odd that I should be receiving threats from both a foreign attorney and your Deputy in the same time frame, leading me to suspect collusion.

Please respond to these requests so that I know action will be taken on these serious and offensive matters. Thank you for your time and consideration.
