Dear Judge Ford;

Pursuant to our telephone conference of December 19th, 1997, I am requesting that you proceed to act on my motion [filed December 8th, 1997] to correct the record.

After serious consideration, and mindful of the uncharted waters that this petition presents, I would like the record to reflect that I have serious reservations about the accuracy of the Notes of Testimony. My allegations raise serious questions which deals with the integrity of our judicial system. I cannot accurately express my level of concern. I hope that your level of concern equals mine in this regard.

I maintain that the transcript as typed does not accurately represent the proceedings. The transcript does accurately match the contents of the audio tape in the possession of the court stenographer. My allegation is that this audio tape has been altered. I believe strongly that Mss. Sherry, your court stenographer, had nothing to do with the alteration of the tape.

Because of the serious implications of my allegation, I believe that a thorough investigation is appropriate prior to your decision to grant or deny my petition. This matter extends far beyond the determination of a support award, and any appeal therefrom. I believe it should be reviewed as a separate matter unrelated to the appeal of the above-cited case.
