**SUMMARY:**

Prior to December 02, 2004, the highest "purge condition" entered against defendant, Elisha Ennis, was \$407.50 for orthodontia. The amount was adjusted downward from \$800.00.

A purge condition of \$3,000.00 is seven (7) times higher than the previous highest purge amount.

There is no evidence to support a finding that defendant can meet this purge condition.

The Order of December 02, 2004 is improper because defendant cannot meet the purge condition as ordered.
