Dear Governor Romney,

On December 7, 2003, Edward "Zed" McLarnon wrote you under the letter-head of CASK – Coalition Against State-Sanctioned Kidnapping. His letter references the tyrannical abuse of the judicial system by persons operating from inside the courts; judges, and others operating under the knowledge and consent of the authorities.

I am writing to you to confirm that the courts have degenerated into a tyrannical branch of government whose actions are preserved and protected by use of criminal actions, including altering the physical evidence and records of court proceedings to support unlawful judicial rulings. As stated in Mr. McLarnon's letter, when a person truthfully challenges the integrity of the courts, instead of an investigation, that person is met with threats of personal harm to their lifestyle, livelihood, and more. These persons become targets for character assassination of the most despicable kind.

In Massachusetts, I understand that Attorney Barbara Johnson, a candidate for your office, is currently undergoing professional attacks and is fighting formal proceedings to have her disbarred. Hers is not the only case where persons of integrity are attacked maliciously and without provocation for speaking the truth. Other attorneys have been threatened with professional sanctions for attempting to expose judicial corruption in your State. I am presently under similar attack in Pennsylvania for attempting to get an investigation into the alteration of audio records of court hearings.

Judge Alan M. Black of Pennsylvania filed a false complaint against me with the Pennsylvania Supreme Court Disciplinary Board. His complaint is totally without merit, citing events more than two years old, when he could have cited more recent allegations of events in his court.

I brought his false charges to the attention of the Pennsylvania Attorney General, and demanded an investigation of the criminal acts within the court. Their office responded that no investigation of the criminal acts within our courts would be conducted. Not surprisingly, the primary media outlets are complicit in refusing to bring this issue before the public. Clearly, the integrity of our courts has been compromised.

Those of us who consider ourselves to be responsible citizens have considered the dangers and the potential damage if public confidence in the judicial system is undermined. For myself, I have accepted that public confidence in the judicial system is less important and is subordinate to "the integrity of the judicial system", and have pledged to persevere in this battle against despicable people who are perpetrating more harm to America than the Al Qaeda bombers did on September 11,2001.

The arguments raised by Mr. McLarnon appear on the surface to be irrational arguments that can not possibly be true. I am writing to inform you that I am witness to similar treatment in Pennsylvania courts. Further, I produced two witnesses who testified that the transcribed Notes of hearings are inaccurate, and other witnesses [produced by the court] testified that the transcribed records match the audio records 100%. These same court witnesses confirmed that the audio records left their custody prior to being transcribed. This leaves only one reasonable alternative; that the audio records were electronically edited before being transcribed.


Altering court records is a criminal act, obstruction of justice and record tampering, at the least. We cannot survive as a free Nation if the individual liberties secured under our Constitution are so flagrantly discarded. This abuse of individual liberties must cease.

Victims of judicial tyranny and corruption provide the first evidence of the decline of the American political structure. There is other, less specific evidence, but judicial corruption is an issue that can be, and must be confronted.

Our Nation needs leaders with personal and public integrity. These leaders will carry the torch against enemies from abroad, and from within. It is with this in mind that I appeal to you. I respectfully ask that you give credence to the facts asserted by Mr. McLarnon and CASK, and issue an Executive Order in Massachusetts that instigates an investigation of the judicial system, especially within the family courts, since hearings there are generally conducted without a jury .

Our children deserve no less. America deserves no less. Thank you for your attention in this matter.
